## ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- i. Abstracts must be submitted in English using the Online Abstract Submission Form. Text must be typewritten in Times New Roman, font size 10.
- ii. Abstracts submitted by fax, email or paper copy will NOT be considered.
- iii. Select your preferred mode of presentation (Oral / Video / Electronic Poster).
- iv. Abstract texts should have the following structure: Introduction, Objectives, Methods, Results and Conclusions.
- v. The abstract may contain up to a maximum of 250 words. Do not include graphs, tables, diagrams, pictures or references in the abstract.
- vi. All abstracts regardless of final mode of presentation, **should be submitted on or before 30 April 2019**.
- vii. Once the abstract submission has been successful, a confirmation email will be sent to you. Please ensure your email address is correct.
- viii. Selected presenting authors will be notified by **15 May 2019**.
- ix. For each abstract, the Registration Fees for the presenting author should be paid by **01 June 2019**.
